

RESOLUTION 21-06

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE NAMING OF THE TOWN PARK

WHEREAS, the Town of Millville is excitedly anticipating the opening of its first municipal park, representing the culmination of several years of expense and effort to bring to the Town an area for recreation and fellowship; and

WHEREAS, by way of background, over five years ago, the Town purchased the land from J. Scott Evans Sr., who sold the land to the Town in order to create a park, rather than selling the land for development; and

WHEREAS, the Town then applied for and received a grant covering one-quarter of the purchase price from the State Division of Parks and Recreation at the Department of Natural Resources & Environmental Control and, as part of that grant, restricted the land to public outdoor recreation or conservation purposes, to remain open for public use, in accordance with the Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund, (Title 30, Ch. 54, Subchap. II of the Delaware Code); and


WHEREAS, J. Scott Evans Sr. received the land from his parents, John H. Evans, known as Captain Jack, and Elizabeth B. Evans, known as Betty, both longtime Millville residents; and

WHEREAS, the Town would like to extend its gratitude to all of those who have worked on the park project and supported its progress, as well as those who will continue to do so, whether through financial support, direct efforts, ideas, patronage, or otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Town would like to honor the history of the land and, in particular, extend its gratitude to J. Scott Evans and his parents, Captain Jack and Betty Evans;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Millville that the park located on tax parcel no. 134-12.00-395.00 is hereby named "EVANS PARK at MILLVILLE."
