

HOMETOWN HEROES BANNERS

The Town thought it would be a great idea to start a Hometown Heroes Banner Program at Evans Park to honor our local veterans and first responders who originated from the Town of Millville. We will be working in conjunction with John Gilbert and Jason Gerlach of Holiday Outdoor Décor who will guide us through this venture.

The advertising for this project is usually done via social media, newspaper, and website. The VFW will assist in locating any veterans from the Town of Millville proper. The banners will be placed on both sides of the poles around Evans Park, there are approximately 30.

Cost:

24" x 48" vinyl banner: \$104.95 each

30" x 60" vinyl banner: \$124.95 each

Bracket Kit: \$64.95 per kit

The banners are made of heavy weight block out vinyl which is extremely durable and holds up very well. The mounting bracket is made of high-quality aluminum. Holiday Décor can do the installation, however, they wait until there are several to install at one time before they can give me a price.

The Program asks that we scan all the pictures we collect and to organize the information for each veteran in a spreadsheet that they provide so there can be no mistake on names, ranks, branch of service etc. They will provide us with a proof of EACH banner so EVERY participant can see their banner before it's printed and confirm it's to their liking.

All banners are printed on both sides. The families can elect to include whatever information they choose for each Veteran and/or First Responder and Outdoor Décor will try to accommodate the family and include what they can given the banner size. Once a template is chosen and the information is sent, it takes up to 2 weeks to send all the proofs. Once they get final approval, it's another 2 weeks until the banners are received.

If we want delivery for Memorial Day, they allow a total of 6 weeks to account for the seasonal rush. Right now, we have discussed displaying the banners Memorial Day through Veteran's Day, since we don't want them to interfere with the Christmas pole lights.

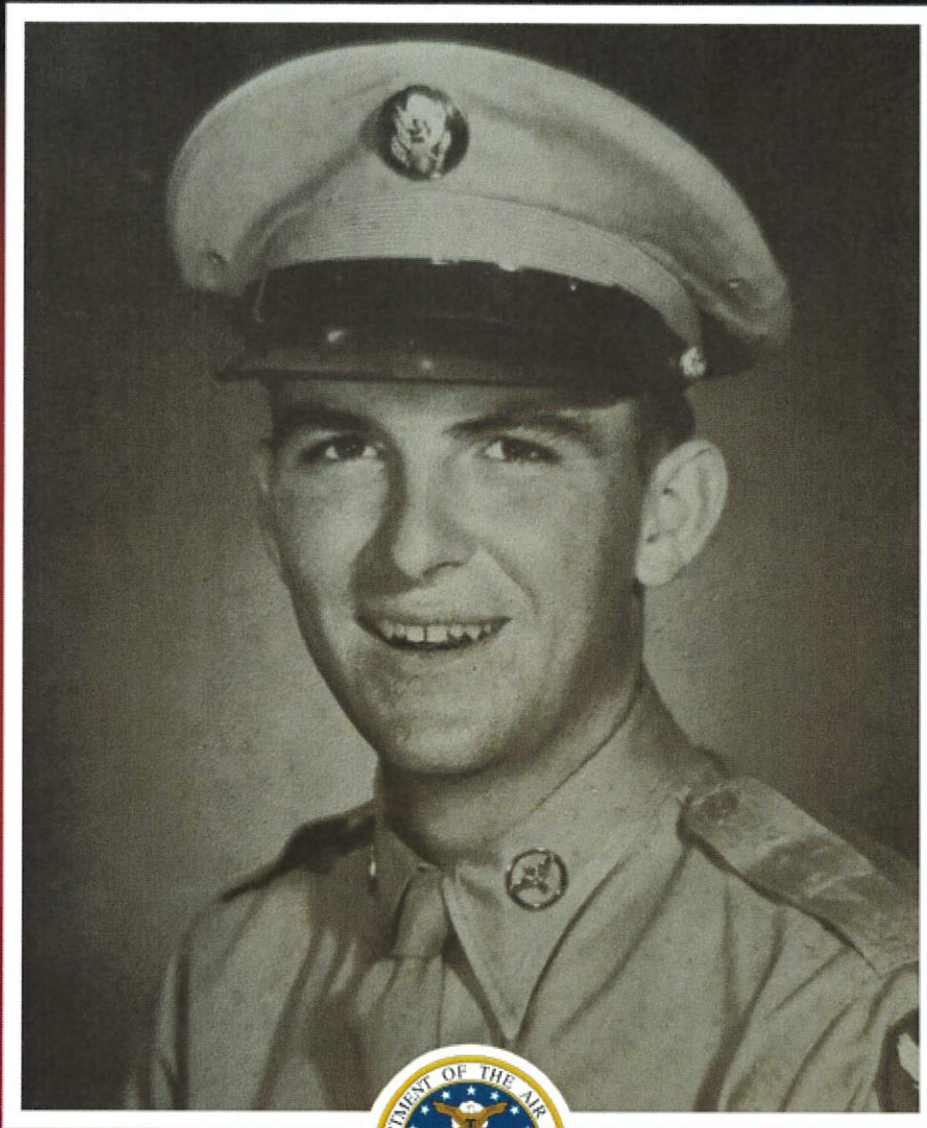
