

MINUTES OF THE MILLVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING November 14, 2023 @ 7:00 p.m. Regular Meeting

1. Call to Order:

Mayor Belinko called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the **Pledge of Allegiance**. <u>**Present</u></u>: Mayor Ronald Belinko, Deputy Mayor Sharon Brienza, Secretary Joseph Parent, Councilman Robert Wisgirda, Town Manager Deborah Botchie, Asst.
