Town Events September Summary:

The Bethany-Fenwick Chamber of Commerce held their monthly membership meeting inside the community center on October 4th. Guest speakers from Mercantile Processing Inc. spoke about the recent changes affecting credit card processing.

The following week a dedication of the memorial stones for Blue Star and Gold Star families was held. These stones are now permanently located in the park and were sponsored by the Gardeners by the Sea group. Although the weather forced the dedication ceremony to be moved indoors, it was well attended. Several Veterans and Gold Star families gave moving accounts of their military experiences.

On October 28th, the Town of Millville sponsored an annual community Halloween event, the Trail of Treats in Evans Park.
