A RESOLUTION TO HIRE A FULL-TIME PARKS & RECREATION COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has the power to hire new employees at such compensation as the Town Council, by Resolution, shall determine; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has complied with all regulations regarding advertising the position, applicant screening and interviews, and notified the successful applicant and all other applicants of his or her status in writing; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has chosen *Kathleen Yingling* to fill the position of Receptionist for the Town of Millville.

NOW, THEREFORE, let it be resolved that the Mayor and Town Council approves the Town Manager's decision on hiring said *Kathleen Yingling* as an at-will, non-contractual employee at the following compensation and terms, in addition to those in the Town of Millville Personnel Policy Manual:

- ❖ Hourly Wage: \$29.23 – Annualized: \$57,000.00
- ❖ Hours of work: Typically, 8:30 a.m. till 4:30 p.m. flexible to meet the needs of the park.
- ❖ Six (6) month training (probation) period.
