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Absentee Ballot
Instructions for Completing and Returning
Town of Millville 2025 Municipal Election

- Determine the number of candidates for which you are permitted to vote by reading the information at the top of the ballot.
- Vote by putting an “X” in the box to the left of the name of the candidate or candidates for whom you want to vote for. **NOTE: IF YOU VOTE FOR MORE THAN THE ALLOWABLE NUMBER OF CANDIDATES FOR COUNCIL, THE VOTES SHALL NOT BE COUNTED.**
- If you make a mistake or change your mind, clearly indicate by words and arrows the candidate for whom you want to vote for.
- If you spoil your ballot, contact the Town Hall for instructions on how to obtain a replacement.
- Once you are satisfied that you have completed your ballot, fold it neatly and put it in the **(brown) BALLOT ENVELOPE.**
- Seal the **BALLOT ENVELOPE.** Read the oath that is printed on the **BALLOT ENVELOPE**, then sign and date the **BALLOT ENVELOPE** in the space provided. Put the **BALLOT ENVELOPE** into the (white) **MAILING ENVELOPE**, seal the mailing envelope and then mail the sealed mailing envelope with the **BALLOT ENVELOPE** enclosed or deliver the sealed mailing envelope to the Town Hall.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Absentee ballots must be received at the Town Hall no later than 6:00 PM on Saturday, March 1, 2025.
- Any person who fraudulently signs the name of a voter on any voucher envelope shall be guilty of forgery and, upon conviction, be punished as provided by law.
- Any person in voting or attempting to vote by himself or herself, or any other person, pursuant to the provisions of the absentee ballot law, violates any of the laws of this State enacted to secure the secrecy and independence of the voter, preserve the freedom and purity of the elections and prevent fraud, corruption and intimidation shall be punished as provided by law.
