**Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**  
**Town of Millville 2026 Municipal Election**

This FAQ is intended to provide guidance and to answer questions voters may have navigating the voting process for the Town of Millville.

The Town's 2026 election is scheduled for March 7, 2026, 11:00 AM – 6:00 PM. The poll location is at Evans Park located at 32517 Dukes Drive, Millville, Delaware 19967.

**1. Do I have to register to vote in the Town of Millville?**

*No.* However, you must register to vote in Delaware by applying with the Department of Elections. Call the Sussex County office at (302) 856-5367 to register by phone. You can register in person at the Department of Elections located at 119 N. Race Street in Georgetown, Delaware or visit online: <https://ivote.de.gov/VoterView/registrant/newregistrant>

**2. How do I request an absentee ballot?**

You can either pick up a "Request for an Absentee Ballot" form at the Town Hall from 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM Monday – Friday **OR** you can obtain a "Request for an Absentee Ballot" from the website <https://millville.delaware.gov/2026/02/17/absentee-ballot/> **OR** call the Town Hall to have one mailed to you.

**3. How do I submit my completed "Request an Absentee Ballot" form?**

You can either mail it to: Town of Millville, 36404 Club House Road, Millville, Delaware, Attn: ABSENTEE BALLOT FORM **OR** you can place it in the mailbox on the front porch of Town Hall **OR** hand deliver to the front office.

**4. When is cut off time to request an absentee ballot request form?**

Request forms are due no later than noon the day before the election, which is Friday, March 6th, 2026.

**5. When is my absentee ballot due?**

Absentee ballots are due no later than March 7th at 6:00 p.m. Absentee ballots received after this time will not be counted. If mailing, please allow enough time for the Town to receive the ballot.
