TOWN MANAGER'S UPDATE

- ❖ We received conditional approval from DelDOT for our Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant application to construct a sidewalk along Old School Lane and a crosswalk across Route 26.
- ❖ Senate Bill 23 challenges- We continue to monitor the ongoing uncertainty since the implementation of Senate Bill 23. Based on current census population figures, Millville does not presently exceed the statutory population threshold.
- ❖ Pole Barn Invitation to Bid: The Invitation to Bid for the new pole barn project is currently open. We are accepting sealed bids and look forward to receiving competitive proposals. All bids received will be publicly opened on **September 10, 2026, at 2:00 p.m.** Following the bid opening, staff will review the submissions and prepare a recommendation for Town Council consideration.

- ❖ Municipal Boundary Initiative: Boundary letters have been prepared and mailed to 13 property owners whose parcels are partially within Town limits. This effort supports the Comprehensive Plan by creating more consistent municipal boundaries. There will be no additional cost to these property owners to annex the remainder of their parcels into the Town.
- ❖ Evans Park Community Center – New Programming: We are excited to add line dancing to our fall programming. R&R Line Dancing will host a kickoff social dance event on Friday, October 16. A six-week beginner class will begin in November.
