



RESOLUTION 27-11

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT PROPOSAL FROM COASTAL TECHNOLOGY GROUP FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ADDITIONAL SECURITY CAMERAS AT EVANS PARK

WHEREAS, the Town of Millville (“Town”) recognizes the importance of providing a safe and secure environment for residents and visitors utilizing Evans Park; and

WHEREAS, the Town has identified a need for additional security cameras at Evans Park to enhance monitoring and security throughout the park; and

WHEREAS, Coastal Technology Group has submitted a proposal to the Town of Millville for the installation of additional cameras and related equipment at Evans Park in the total amount of Twenty-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Eighteen Dollars \$23,918.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town has secured grant funding in the amount of Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Dollars \$9,990.00 to assist with the cost of this project; and

WHEREAS, the remaining project cost to be funded by the Town is Thirteen Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars \$13,928.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the installation of additional security cameras at Evans Park will further the health, safety, and welfare of residents and park users.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Millville that Eileen Scerra, Town Manager, is hereby authorized to execute the proposal, agreement, purchase order, and any other documents reasonably necessary to proceed with the project, consistent with the amount authorized by this Resolution.
